- 1 Subsection (a) of section 3 of chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:-
- 3 At least 1 of the 5 commissioners shall be, upon appointment, a current full time resident of
- 4 Hampden, Hampshire, Franklin or Berkshire county.
