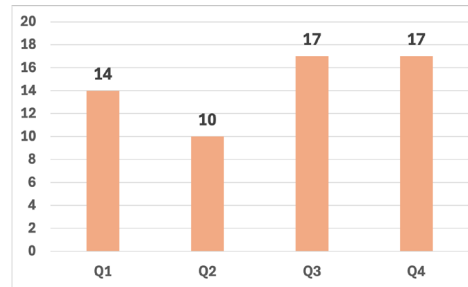

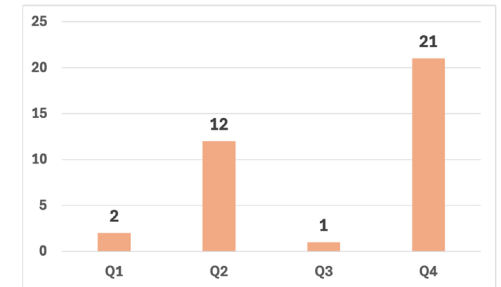

\* Of the 58 tennis alerts, 7 were provided to the International Tennis Integrity Agency (ITIA) as intelligence reports as they do not relate to events sanctioned by the main tennis tours. However, some players engaged in those events may fall under the body's Tennis Anti-Corruption Program (TACP). Similarly, of the 36 table tennis alerts, 32 were reported on events not organised by the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF).

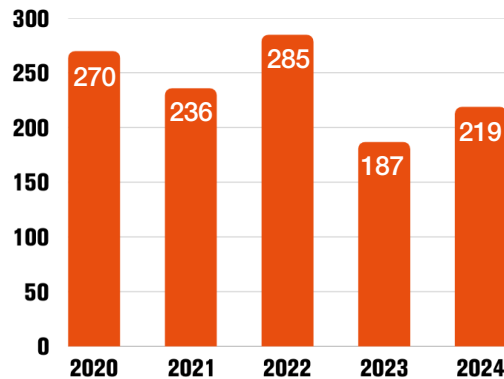

A downward trend in the proportion of matches reported for suspicious betting activity that are on Tennis matches continued in 2024. The 58 tennis matches reported in 2024 represent 26% of all matches reported. This is down from 29% in 2023.
